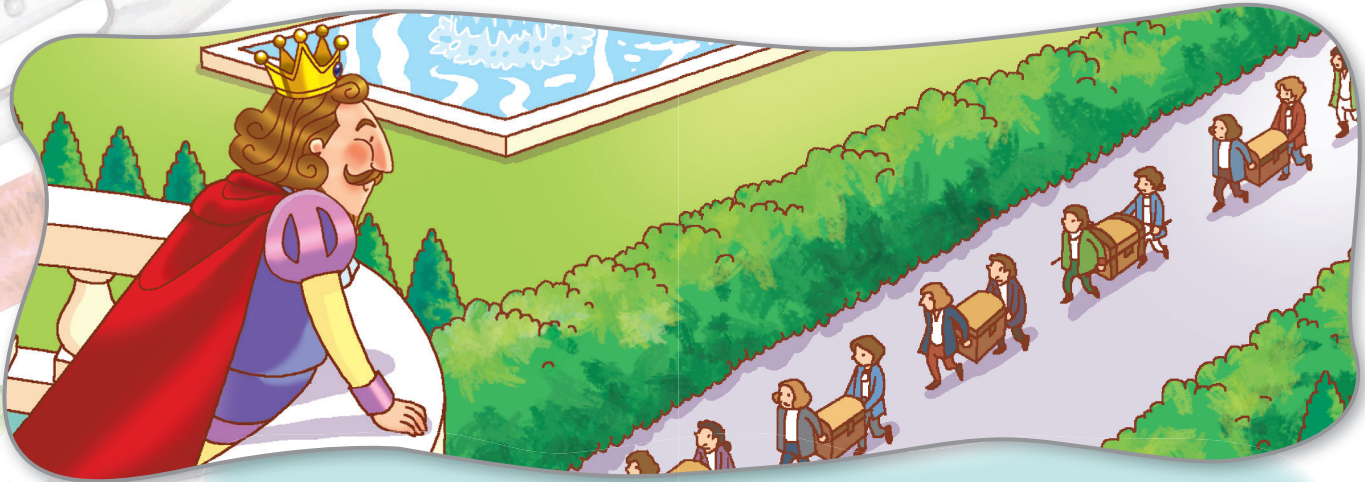


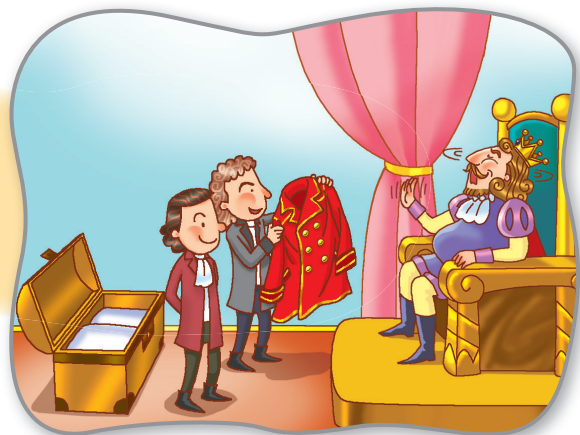

The Emperor's New Clothes

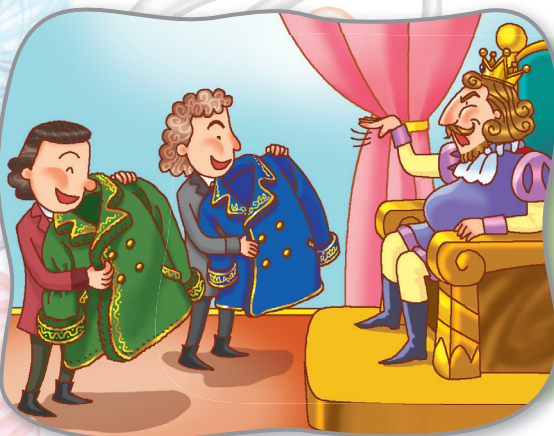


The Emperor was the richest man in the land. He loved buying new things, especially clothes. Every day, tailors visited the palace with new clothes for the Emperor.

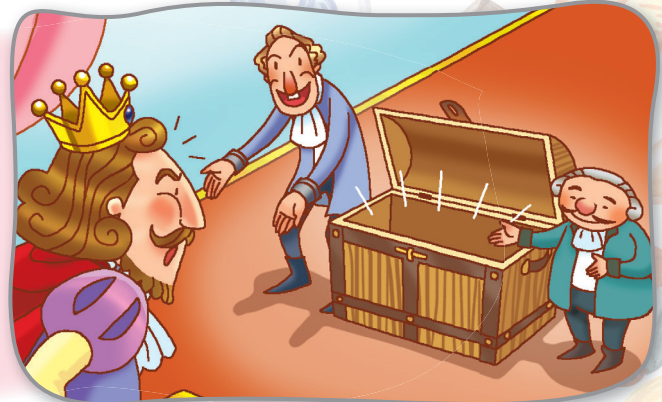
More tailors visited the palace.
