If I become an astronaut, I will have a very exciting and adventurous life. I will see amazing things in space. I may even meet aliens on other planets!


Some people think girls can't be astronauts, but I won't let anything stop me from following my dream! I am going to join a space camp in the summer holidays and do some astronaut training!
