spoon because I am not very good at using chopsticks!

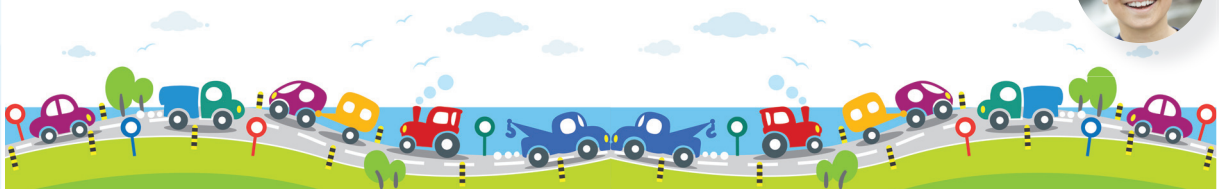
Kevin is good at Chinese, Maths, Visual Arts — everything! He often helps me with Chinese.
