Don't let our animals disappear!

The animals on the map on the right are all **endangered**. This means that they may soon become extinct — dying out just like the dinosaurs. It is possible that your grandchildren will never see a real elephant, tiger or orangutan. And they are not the only animals that may disappear. Over 12,500 animals are endangered. Why? **HUMANS**! Human activities such as forest clearing, pollution and hunting are the main causes of the problem.



Forests are very important for life on Earth. They provide clean air, food, and a home for many animals. However, forests are cleared to 10 make way for roads, towns and farms.

Many orangutans are losing their homes and starving to death because of forest clearing. Orangutans will become extinct unless we stop destroying their forest homes.

Pollution

15 When waste is dumped in the sea, it is a big problem for fish and sea animals. For example, many sea turtles die after they accidentally eat plastic bags floating in the sea. Also,
20 since sea turtles need to lay their eggs on sandy beaches, rubbish on these beaches can trap the babies and prevent them from reaching the ocean. Sea turtles will become extinct
25 unless we stop polluting the sea.

Hunting

Although animal hunting is banned in many places, millions of animals are still killed by hunters every year. Tigers are hunted for their fur and rhinos are hunted for their horns. Elephants are killed for their beautiful long tusks, which are made of ivory. In Africa, about 30,000 elephants are killed each year. Their tusks are used to make 30 ivory jewellery, ornaments and chopsticks. Elephants will become extinct unless we stop

buying ivory products.
